Thanks to your past generosity, The Miriam Hospital Women's Association has been successful in funding equipment that has enhanced the services of The Miriam Hospital.

Here are the 2023 equipment requests. This equipment will greatly enhance the hospital's care, commitment, and outstanding service to a large number of patients and nursing staff.

MRI Screening Device for the MRI Department

The MRI patient screening device is capable of screening for both ferrous and non-ferrous items, providing protection from both adverse magnetic interaction as well as metallic heating that could lead to burns. This device provides the highest levels of safety for approximately 5,630 patients per year.

Dri-Scope Aid Jet Stream for Endoscopy Department

Effective drying of endoscopes after reprocessing helps to prevent disease transmission, improving patient safety with zero harm. Protecting over 4,000 patients per year.

Laptops & CPR Manikins for the Center for Professional Practice and Innovation

Effective, timely and efficient training of nursing staff is paramount. Three new laptops will be used for orientation of new staff and their continuing professional development. Four new CPR manikins will enhance training with the newest technology in feedback devices.
